

Compliance Statement regarding Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment

Directive 2012/19/EU of July 4, 2012, as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/849 of May 30, 2018 (hereinafter referred to as the "WEEE Directive") and the German Act governing the sale, return and environmentally sound disposal of electrical and electronic equipment (hereinafter referred to as the "ElektroG") provide for statutory registration of electrical and electronic equipment for private and commercial use. The aim is to reduce electronic waste and create a legal framework for the environmentally friendly disposal of such old appliances.

The products manufactured by Lauterbach GmbH are modular test systems that are used to develop microprocessor-based electronic systems. According to §2 para. 6 ElektroG, the devices fall under category 6 "small IT and telecommunications equipment where none of the external dimensions exceeds 50 centimeters" and are for exclusive use in other than private households.

Lauterbach GmbH as manufacturer of B2B devices declares that the above-mentioned products, which are marketed under the Lauterbach brand, meet the legal requirements regarding the take-back, reuse, recycling and environmentally sound disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment and are registered under WEEE reg. no. DE 84574330.
